Room to Read is educating the world's most vulnerable children with an increasing scale and level of impact. As the non-profit expanded, they became painfully aware that a modern expense and time tracking solution was needed to support this growth. "Our manual, Excel-based process was simply not scalable. We were always behind schedule on our close dates and

had to constantly chase people for receipts," said Shari Freedman. CFO at Room to Read. Leading a small finance team, Freedman knew they had to find a way to optimize employees' time to focus on more impactful work. She knew they needed a more integrated, automated system.

reimbursement process. "The integration between systems works beautifully, and gives us so much time back," said Freedman. With over fifty bank accounts in various countries and reimbursements in nineteen local currencies, manually processing and coding expenses was cumbersome. Nexonia automates and expedites the entire process with custom rules, approval workflows, and integrations with the general ledger, so users get reimbursed seven days faster.

Nexonia helped simplify the audit process and reduced the time to close by more than 80%. Additionally, as Room to Read grows, the solution scales with them, allowing finance to meet increased demand without adding headcount.
